Introduction

India has gone live with e-Way Bill on 1st of April 2018. This notification contains information relevant to the e-Way bill for SAP ECC and SAP S/4HANA On-premise customers.

A waybill is a receipt or a document issued by a carrier providing details and instructions related to the shipment of consignment of goods. The details include name of consignor, consignee, point of origin of consignment, consigned destination and route.

E-way bill is an electronic document generated on the National Informatics Centre (NIC) portal evidencing movement of goods.

Business Background/Impact

Goods movement from one location to another location and carrying a value more than INR 50,000 must have the e-Way bill along with the consignment, while being shipped by the transporter.

Solution Proposal

e-Way Bill solution provided by SAP has two ways:

1. Manual Process - Update the e-Way bill number in SAP system: SAP provides the report to update the e-Way bill number (EWN), Valid From and Valid To periods for each invoice that is created in SAP ECC and SAP S/4HANA On-premise.

The assumption here is that the e-Way bill is created using the NIC portal by the Tax Payer via manual inputs to NIC.

2. Automated Process - With direct integration to NIC system via GSP: This is a licensed solution that is being developed by SAP which will provide direct integration between the SAP ECC or SAP S/4HANA On-Prem systems and the NIC via certified GSPs using the SAP Cloud Integration Platform. This will enable the tax payers to upload the payload from the backend SAP system to the NIC portal, generate the e-Way bill and link the e-Way bill Number (EWN) with the billing document in the backend system. The proposed release to customer (RTC) date for the solution is 30th April 2018 and the detailed roadmap and scope will be shared shortly.
